ORDINANCE NO. 9-99

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODE OF ORDINANCES OF CITY OF SPIRIT LAKE, IOWA, 1998 BY AMENDING SECTION 135.09(6) REGARDING RESTORATION OF PUBLIC PROPERTY AFTER EXCAVATION IN THE CITY.

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Spirit Lake, Iowa:

Section 1. Section 135.09(6) is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

6. Restoration of Public Property. Streets, Sidewalks, Alleys, and other public property disturbed in the course of the work shall be restored to the condition of the property prior to the commencement of the work, or in a manner satisfactory to the City. All excavation shall be mechanically compacted in lifts not to exceed 12 inches. All excavation that requires pavement removal shall before replacing, saw all paving edges and the paving will be replaced with six (6) inches of 3500psi concrete. In the event that the excavation is under a street, driveway, sidewalk, or any other paving, the paving shall be replaced within 72 hours after the completion of the excavation. The City has the right to finish any improper or unfinished work to protect the Public from harm. The permit holder/property owner will bear any expenses incurred. The City will be held harmless by the permit holder/property owner in regards to any and all claims of injury or damage arising from acts or omissions of the authority of this permit. It is the permit holder/property owner's responsibility to protect the public. All barricades and safety fence are the permit holder/property owner's responsibility.


Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective after its final passage and publication is provided by law.
